The Reason

On the 10th of October 2010 millions of people around the world will mark World Homeless Day in many varied ways and change the lives of homeless people in their local community. World Mental Health Day, which is supported by the United Nations (UN), is annually held on October 10th to raise public awareness about mental health issues worldwide. This event promotes open discussions on illnesses, as well as investments in prevention and treatment services. The Annual Social Inclusion Cup held by Streets Revolution CIC / Oxford Health NHS Foundation Trust will be held at the grounds of Warneford hospital. A 6 a side football tournament for socially excluded players and partner organisations to join together through football, participants must be aged 16+ and it is a FREE to enter tournament. The Tournament

Please note, Squads will consist of EIGHT players.

The groups will follow a format of a guaranteed MINIMUM of 5 matches and 2 opportunities of winning the OXFORD SOCIAL INCLUSION trophy, and the FAIR PLAY TEAM AWARD.

With 5 league matches for each team, the top teams from each league will then contest the main competition knock-out stages to a final.

Individual trophies will be awarded for finals with a sponsored returnable team trophy for the main competition winners.

The programme is arranged so that each team play their matches over an approximately 4 hour period thus ensuring that the time between each of your games is kept to a minimum.

Refreshments - will be on available. There is also parking available.

Once again ALL footballs will be provided by the organisers; therefore all other footballs will be barred from the tournament playing area. Please advise all those attending as they will be requested to return any footballs to their cars at the entrance.

With entries limited, we would recommend that your application form is returned as soon as possible but no later than 5th October 2010.

Entries will be accepted strictly on a first come first served basis; acceptance will be notified by return e-mail and full details will be forwarded approximately seven days before the tournament is to be held and unsuccessful applications will be returned within fourteen days of receipt.

Additional application forms are available upon request ,If an e-mail address is provided overleaf all correspondence will be sent to this address, if not please enclose a suitably sized STAMPED ADDRESSED RETURN ENVELOPE with the correct postage.

Tournament rules and full details will be forwarded to you at least 7 days prior to the event. Please note that in the unlikely event of the tournament being cancelled, notification will be given via contact details any costs to yourself will be NOT be reimbursed No refunds can be made.

Directions

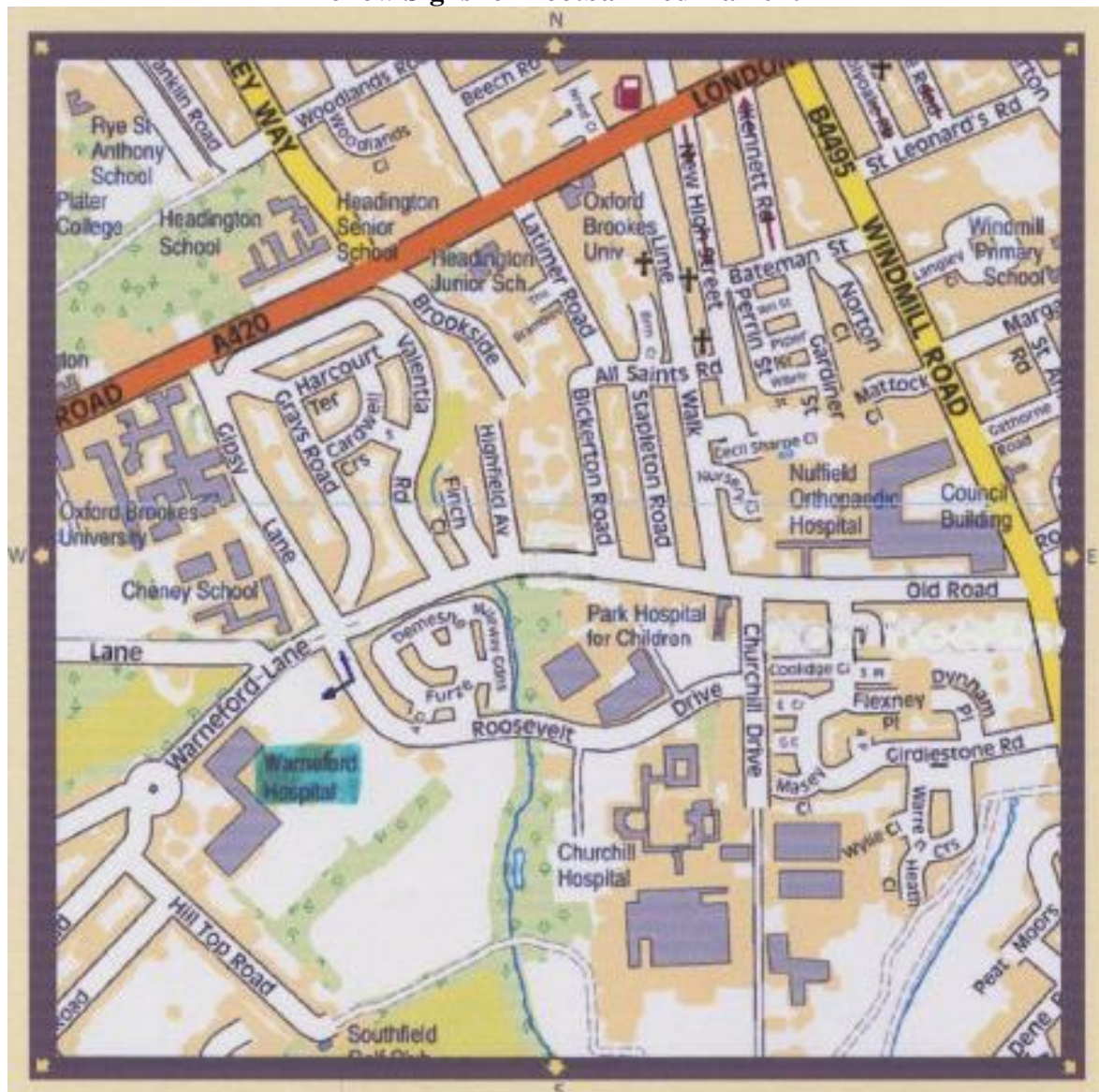
The Warneford Hospital is in Headington, 2.5 miles east of Oxford City centre. It can be reached easily from the M40.

From the east, turn off at junction 8 or 8a, take the A40 then the A420 to Headington centre and follow signs for the hospitals.

From the north, turn off at junction 9, take the A34 then the A40 northern ring road to the Marston junction (B4150). Turn left onto the B4495 towards Headington and follow signs for the hospitals.

From the south and west, approach from the eastern ring road and B4495.
