1. Job Profile

Role Description

PURPOSE

- In-Form is Homeless Link's client recording system and is an application built on the Salesforce platform. It supports homelessness and housing services across the country to record, manage and report on the work they do with people experiencing homelessness.
- The In-Form Product Manager will be responsible for shaping and owning the product strategy for In-Form, grounded in a deep understanding of the market, customers, users and the wider charity and housing landscape.
- The role will lead on market, customer and competitive insight, product positioning, business cases, pricing, roadmaps and go-to-market planning,
- The Product Manager is accountable for product outcomes and for the overall success of the In-Form product portfolio.
- The Product Manager is also accountable for defining how success is measured and monitored over time.

ACCOUNTABILITY

The Product Manager will be a member of the In-Form Product Team and will report to the Head of Product.

LOCATION

Either based in the Homeless Link office in London for a minimum of 2 days a week or 100% remote working (with visits to the London office three or four times a year).

RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Product strategy & vision

- Define and maintain the vision, value propositions and multi-year strategy for the In-Form product portfolio;
- Ensure individual product roadmaps and releases are aligned to strategic goals and organisational priorities.
- Ensure product strategy, propositions and pricing decisions support Homeless Link's charitable objectives and deliver positive outcomes for people experiencing homelessness, while maintaining organisational sustainability.

2. Customer research, market & competitive insight

- Lead market research and competitor benchmarking;

- Track market drivers (e.g. technology, legislation, sector change) and translate into opportunity areas for product development.
 - Drive customer & prospect research;
 - Define target segments, buyer/user profiles and prioritised use cases.
- 3. Business and commercial**
 - Build business cases and financial models (e.g. revenue, costs, pricing, bundles, discounts) to secure investment.
 - Develop product propositions and launch plans;
 - Coordinate with Sales and Marketing to prepare go-to-market activities.
 - Recommend where to invest (and not invest) across the product portfolio, making transparent trade-offs between impact, risk, cost and opportunity.
 - 4. Roadmaps & prioritisation**
 - Own and maintain internal and external roadmaps, prioritising outcomes that deliver customer value and commercial viability within agreed usability and technical constraints.
 - 5. Product lifecycle management**
 - Define and embed lifecycle processes across the product portfolio, covering ideation, research and validation, proposition development, progression to delivery and launch
 - Review and plan retirement of products or features that no longer deliver value.
 - 6. Product performance & analytics**
 - define and oversee KPIs, and product analytics to measure them;
 - interpret usage and commercial data to recommend actions.
 - 7. Stakeholder and cross-functional collaboration**
 - Present product strategy and updates to leadership, sales, partners and external audiences.
 - Act as a product ambassador work closely with Product Owner, UX Designer, Technical Architect, Release Manager, Sales, Support, Delivery and Marketing to ensure commercial and operational readiness.
 - Ensure teams across the organisation have a shared understanding of product strategy, target customers, value propositions and priorities
 - 8. Governance and Information Security**
 - Maintain product artefacts (business cases, pricing docs, roadmaps, competitor dossiers, stakeholder briefs) and ensure decisions are recorded and communicated.

- Work with technical and organisational stakeholders to ensure product strategy and roadmap security, accessibility and regulatory requirements.

GENERAL

- Roles and objectives in Homeless Link may change. All members of staff are expected to be proactively responding to changing business needs
- All members of staff are expected to undertake any other responsibilities or tasks that are consistent with their role and/or reasonably required by the Chief Executive
- To take part in Homeless Link training, events, and seminars as appropriate.

QUALIFICATIONS AND SPECIALIST KNOWLEDGE FOR THE ROLE

Essential

- Proven product management knowledge from a SaaS or commercial software product.
- Strong understanding of SaaS product economics, pricing models and commercial forecasting.
- Familiarity with market research methods, customer research techniques and product analytics.
- Good knowledge of product lifecycle, road-mapping and go-to-market planning.

Desirable

- Formal product qualifications (e.g. Pragmatic Institute, AIPMM, CPO programmes) or relevant industry certificates.
- Salesforce certifications or Salesforce partner / ISV training.
- Deep knowledge of the Salesforce ecosystem (Salesforce platform, ISV / OEM packaging / licensing, AppExchange).
- Knowledge of homelessness and / or supported housing sectors

EXPERIENCE AND TRACK RECORD

Essential

- 3+ years (or equivalent) as a Product Manager working on a commercial software product, with demonstrable ownership of strategy, roadmap and business cases.
- Track record of turning market and customer insight into propositions and measurable commercial outcomes.
- Experience working cross-functionally with UX, engineering, sales and marketing to deliver and launch product improvements.
- Strong stakeholder management: presenting to senior leaders, influencing without direct authority and coordinating multiple teams.

Desirable

- Experience working in or with charities, housing or homelessness services (sector knowledge and networks).
- Prior experience with Salesforce ISV/OEM product development or within a Salesforce-centric organisation.
- Experience of B2B sales motions, partner/channel strategies or working with external partners and integrators.

- Willingness and ability to work outside normal office hours.
