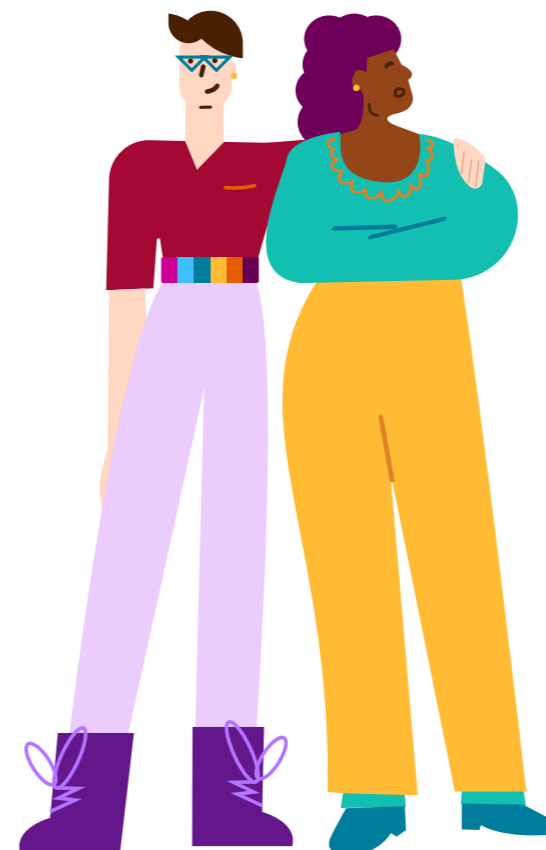

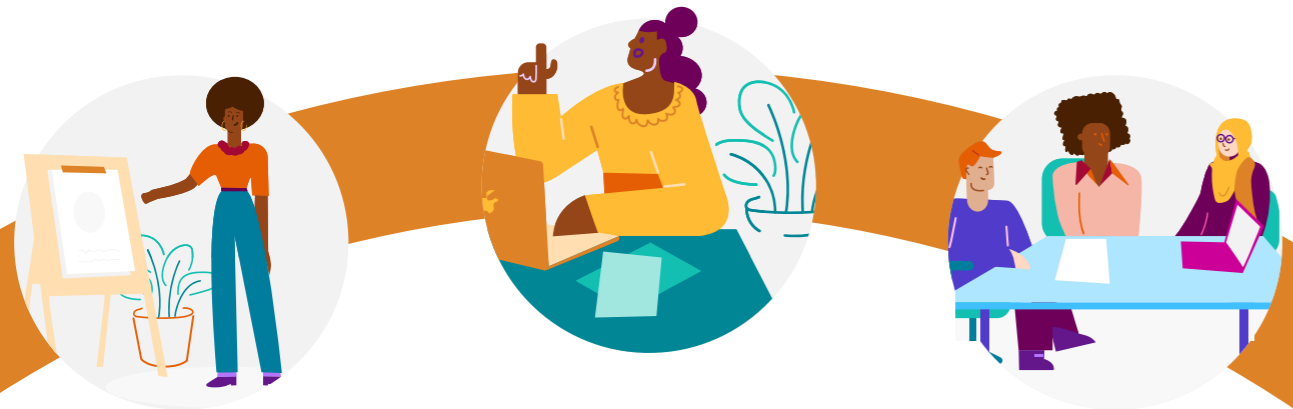

Homeless England is the most comprehensive database of homelessness services. It is constantly updated and lists 1500 projects up and down the country with contact details and service descriptions. You and the people you support can use this information to find homelessness support services available in your area. The database also informs research projects that map the provision of services across the country and trends in the homelessness sector.

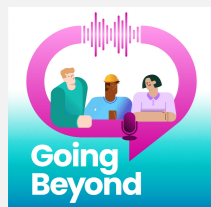

Our recent Breaking the Cycle campaign helped shape the National Plan to End Homelessness, and that progress was driven forward by members lobbying their local MPs, showing their support online, and speaking out in the media.

We also support members to make change happen in their communities and help services build valuable connections with local politicians.
